SIMPLE FORMULA

We start with an opening ritual to check-in, then ask a **QUESTION**. With that starts the **EXPERIMENT**, it might be from a special guest, on a shared topic or about beta testing an engagement tool. We talk it through, and then we **DEBRIEF**. What helped? Hindered? Insights? Take-aways? Finally, we **SHARE** the outcomes.

RESEARCH PROJECT

STIMULATING CONVERSATION is easy. But it takes practice. This is one of our many *Dialogue Experiments* helping people examine their conversations, test out ways to converse, and share feedback to get better.

Trying this out with *Engagement Makers* gives you the extra benefit of increasing your entrepreneurship and ripple effect. Looking forward to hearing your curiosity and your breakthroughs.

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Tuesday Talks: Co-host an Experiment with Engagement Makers

Looking for engagement for your topic?

Our community is into building engagement. We bring people together for all sorts of initiatives. Each Tuesday, it's a different mix of people, but you'll usually find people who work in events, outreach, communications or organizational development.

If you have a topic to discuss, and are looking for ideas of engagement makers, this is the place for you. We'd be glad to explore your topic, question, or tool – looking at the angles of inclusion, participation, outreach, collective experience and crowdsourcing.

TYPICAL FORMAT

The 90 minutes are structured as a *Dialogue Experiment* as described in the *Tiny Book of Dialogue*. Often, like this:

WELCOME. Check-in ritual that sets the tone and direction. (7 min)

QUESTION. Shape your question as an invitation that will attract the group. (3 min)

EXPERIMENT. Explain the intention, establish ground rules and bring your group into conversation(s) or group experiences. (55m)

DEBRIEF. Bring the topic to a close and post the link for reflection on what helped, hindered, learning & take-aways. (15m)

SHARE. Let the group summarize the feedback together, then create a harvest to share widely. (5m)

CLOSE. Thanks, prizes, resources, appreciation. (5m)

SHAPE THE QUESTION

We kick off the dialogue with your question – so ensure it evokes curiosity, energy, exploration, listening and real conversation.

Asking questions is not just a chance to hear other people's views, it is an affirmation that we believe in others' potential. The better the question we ask, the better the conversation we have.

- Is your question relevant to real life, real work and real people?
- Do people care? Is it important or just a pre-scripted re-hash?
- Will your question generate hope, imagination, or fresh views?
- Is there space for depth, progress, action? Deep engagement?
- Will your question invite new questions? Reveal the shadows?

DATA PRIVACY

Participants opt in to being in this community by supplying an email and their areas of interest. We do not share their data and do not send them info about our guests, co-hosts or session content. We simply send the group an invitation to register and work with the people who show up.

If you want to have their details, you can post a link/contact in the chat where they can provide what they like, or not.

The feedback collected in the debrief is central to the Dialogue Experiment Research Project – and is made available to both participants and the wider world.

CIVIC ACTIVISTS
